GLOSSARY OF EXAM BOARD CODES

GCSE/FC = Full Course GCSE/SC = Short Course

GCSE/DA = Double Award

GCSE/B = module: either written exam (“Board Timetabled”) or Controlled Assessment/Coursework (“Not Timetabled”)

H = Higher F = Foundation

An A after a subject means Specification A (as opposed to B), not A level!

“Certification Code” means “add my module marks together to give me a grade”. It is not an actual exam, but it is essential for you to get a grade. Check it is there! Unfortunately it does not always appear in order with its constituent units on the Statement of Entry.

Linear means final exam at the end of the course consisting of 2 papers. Only Edexcel Maths remains this year (for students in sets 4 & 5) with this traditional system which has just been phased out with the coming of new GCSE. However all subjects will revert to this system in 2014!

Module codes include Controlled Assessment units whose marks will be added to those of your written papers. A module with an * was taken in Year 10 or in January 2011, so will not appear on your Summer 2011 Entry Statement unless you are re-sitting it. Don't worry, it is on your account with the Board!

In **Mathematics** you should check that you are only entered for either EDEXCEL modular or linear, not both.

In **French and German** Listening and Reading both tiers are shown on the detailed version. Your teacher will discuss this with you and tell you which tier you are doing nearer the time. You do not do both! Speaking shows “moderated” or “unmoderated”: this refers to the marking method-ignore!

OCR Nationals in Science and BTEC exams are dealt with separately and do not appear here.
