

# Tring School Admissions Policy 2011/2012

---

The school has adopted the County Ranking System for co-ordinated admissions. Consideration will be given to every parent who ranks Tring School. The following rules will apply when admissions are being considered:

The allocation of places to children with SEN is in accordance with section 324 of the education act 1996 and this affords priority over rules 1 to 6.

1. Children in public care (Looked after children).
2. Children for whom it can be demonstrated that they have a particular medical or social need to go to the school.
3. Up to a maximum of 10 places will be available for children who can prove that they have specific religious reasons for attending Tring School.

Priority will be given to children whose parents have been active Church attendees (eg. at least once a month) over a period of time.

Applications must be supported by a letter from a Priest or Minister. If there are more than 10 applications which meet this criteria, priority will be given to those who live nearest the school.

4. Children who have a sibling at the school at the time of application, unless the sibling is in the last year of the normal age-range of the school i.e. Year 13.

A sibling means the sister, brother, half brother or sister, adopted brother or sister, or child of the parent/carer or partner, and in every case living in the same house from Monday to Friday.

5. Children who live in the parishes of Tring, Tring Rural, Aldbury, Wigginton and Little Gaddesden.

If there are more children living in these parishes than there are places then we will give priority to those who live nearest to the school.

6. Children who live nearest to Tring School.
