

**Modern Foreign Languages:  
Homework expectations for parents and pupils.**

The Modern Foreign Languages Department supports the principles and guidelines contained within the Tring School Home Learning Policy.

**Key Stage Three:**

Pupils are given one learning piece of homework per week and one task to be completed from the white homework books: Métro (French) and Logo (German).

**Key Stage Four:**

Pupils are given one learning piece of homework per week and at least one task to be completed from the textbook, white homework books, staff's worksheets, online language sites, past papers, coursework related exercises, speaking exam preparation. In addition to the above there are also likely to be other occasional exercises such as independent research, note taking, presentation preparation etc.

**Key Stage Five:**

Pupils are given several tasks to further develop all four skill areas: listening, speaking, reading and writing. Homework can be set from the textbook, staff's worksheets, online resources etc. Reading and exercises will be set based on current and topical issues. Furthermore, linguists are expected to keep abreast of the current foreign affairs by reading news paper, watching appropriate TV programmes, perusing language websites and/or reading French/German magazines.
