

## **Psychology**

The Psychology Department supports the principles and guidelines contained within the Tring School Home Learning Policy.

Psychology students will be set, at regular intervals, past examination questions to complete at home. This is an essential part of the Psychology course. For past examination questions any pupil obtaining a result more than a grade lower than their target grade will be required to re-do part or all of the question.

They will also be set a variety of practical tasks such as observations and questionnaires in order to develop their knowledge and skills of research methods used by psychologists. They are also required to complete reading and exercises based on current and topical psychological issues. Failure to complete this homework will result in students completing the work during their lunch time. Persistent failure to complete set tasks will result in a meeting to discuss progress with parents and the Head of Sixth Form.
